All performers must appear in appropriate highland attire, including hats. Bands must participate in massed bands at the opening and closing ceremonies on Saturday, with at least the number of members entered, in order to receive travel expenses. All competitors except bands competing for the first time must belong to EUSPBA or a EUSPBA recognized PBA and *must* either identify their membership at registration, or join EUSPBA on the field. Complete rules are located at www.euspba.org/resource/rule/rulesnregs.pdf.

Band travel (Limited to first 12 bands): less than 150 miles: \$100; 151 to 300 miles: \$250; 301 to 500 miles: \$350; over 500 miles: \$500.

Band Events, Prizes and Requirements Schedule: Draw for position held one week prior to event. Bands will be notified of their playing times.

³ In order to challenge G III (should that contest open to challenge) G IV *must* have the required G III set for that day and cannot use its G4 Quick March Set.

Rules, Procedures, and Information

1. All Band and Individual Piping entries must be postmarked by **April 25, 2011**. We apologize however we cannot accept field entries.
2. Saturday admission passes will be mailed prior to the competition.
3. All competitors must wear suitable Highland attire to compete and to accept prizes.
4. Draw for order of play for band contests will be held 2 weeks prior to the contest. Bands will be notified not later than 1 week prior to the contest.
5. Travel allowance for bands: less than 150 miles: \$100; 151 to 300 miles: \$250; 301 to 500 miles: \$350; over 500 miles: \$500. To receive the travel allowance, bands must compete and participate in all massed band events on Saturday
6. These games are EUSPBA sanctioned and EUSPBA rules will apply. **NOTE: The QMM for Grade 4 and Grade 5 bands shall be defined as six to eight parts of march music, simple time, no time limit.** See <http://www.euspba.org/resource/rule/rulesnregs.pdf> for any revised tune requirements.
7. If you have not yet received your Pipe Band Association member number, please annotate "Pending" on the EUSPBA (or other Assoc#) line. We verify member #'s directly with the associations.
8. The Kentucky Scottish Weekend reserves the right to cancel any event for which insufficient entries are received.
9. The number of entries accepted may be limited due to time constraints. Entries will be accepted in order post-marked: first post-marked, last to play. Entries not accepted will be returned with checks as soon as possible.
